Leader's Message

It is now one month until the 2011 general election, and around Hawkes Bay recently I saw John Key's smiling face appearing on billboards in country paddocks. Perhaps each of them should have a flexible arm attached so that when the wind blows, John can also wave at the passing motorists.

There seems little doubt that the National Party will bolt in on November 26, possibly with an increased majority. The polls tell us that currently somewhere around 90 percent of committed voters support either the red, blue or green brands of socialism. Another three percent support the one man bands of United Future and Winston First, and two percent the race-based collectivists of the Maori and Mana parties.

However, over twenty percent of eligible voters chose not to cast a ballot in the 2008 general election, and my instincts tell me that with National so far ahead in the polls, even more voters will choose to stay at home rather than tick the box for Blue Labour. Many voters will have found themselves totally uninspired by the timeservers who represent us in parliament. A growing number will be looking for a political party interested in preserving the individual rights and freedoms of all New Zealanders.

What, then, can the Libertarianz Party offer those voters?

We are the only party interested in downsizing government. We are the only party that believes that New Zealanders should be the masters of their own destiny. We believe that the government is not there to push people into doing that it thinks they should do, but to stand aside and let each of us strive for the goals we set for ourselves. We are the party that treats adults as grown-ups and not as helpless children.

What we offer is a chance for voters to tell the government that even if they don't believe in their stated values of freedom, choice, limited government and personal responsibility, there is a party out there that does.

Shortly, the Libertarianz Party list for this election will be released. On this list, voters will find a group of people willing to put their name beside a principle: that it is wrong for the state to proactively force its people to do anything, and to stop them from doing anything that's peaceful. All other political parties believe that a degree of slavery is acceptable in an apparently civilised country.

Election meetings are being held up and down the country. It is important that representatives of our party speak at some of these meetings. And equally important that members of our party put some of the other candidates on the spot with thorny questions. So if you're not standing as a Libz candidate, it is your duty as a party member to assist those who are standing as candidates. Even in electorates where there is no Libz candidate, our political enemies should not be given an easy ride.

Billboards are able to be erected in all parts of the country. So now is the time to dust off the placards from 2008 and prepare for the coming campaign.

Finally, I am pleased to report that filming and editing for our party's television advertising is well underway. It won't be long before our subversive politics are seen and discussed in living rooms around the country! What happens after that will indeed be interesting.

Labour/National Economic Policy is Insulting

"In the face of the most severe economic crisis since the end of World War II, New Zealanders are looking to political leaders for direction. However all we are being offered is the same old tired formula of divide and bribe," Libertarianz Ohariu candidate and Deputy Leader Sean Fitzpatrick said today.

"Labour/National and their various cling-on parties are all addicted to the concept of central government sucking up as much money as possible and then trickling down on the rest of us. Libertarianz recognizes that economies are, in fact, organic and grow from the bottom up; through the actions of hard working Kiwis acting in their own rational self interest."

Fitzpatrick adds, "New Zealanders have the boldness to get ahead in life, the wisdom to know it takes effort to do so and the maturity to respect those who succeed. By contrast our professional politicians seek to appeal to people's worst instincts: laziness, greed and envy. They regularly behave like overgrown toddlers in Parliament and apparently assume the rest of us to be similarly infantile. Libertarianz says it is time to stop looking for answers from the political elite who see every crisis as merely an opportunity to increase their own power base."

"We need to get unproductive politicians and bureaucrats out of the way of productive workers and businesses. In Parliament Libertarianz will support any legislative step, however small, towards reducing the tax and regulatory burdens on private enterprise".

"Taxing Kiwis into a state of financial hardship and then drip feeding them back their own money in order to keep them dependant on the state is simple cruelty. At the very least, bribing us with our own damn money and then expecting us to be grateful for it is a massive insult. A vote for Libertarianz is the best way for New Zealanders to send the message they refuse treated with such contempt any longer," Fitzpatrick concludes.

"After preparing a short [documentary expose](#) on one of New Zealand's poorest suburbs, which is also the greatest recipient of public welfare, I was amazed at the level of infrastructure and support services available, with seemingly no benefit to the people living there," said Cutting.

'Left wing parties in New Zealand continue to promote the idea that there is a never-ending need for continued public money to go into these areas at the expense of productive New Zealanders.

I would challenge all New Zealanders to view this short film clip and then tell me with a straight face that these people are really living in poverty.

The real problem with poverty in New Zealand comes when an overbearing government reduces individual's sense of self-confidence and hope. Poverty is artificially defined in New Zealand by Statistics NZ as a relative measure rather than an absolute one.

This means that if everyone in New Zealand became instantly richer, official poverty would not change. Conversely if a billionaire moved in New Zealand it would increase official poverty. New Zealanders are being conned into supporting policies that can never solve the problem because the problem is defined in a way that means it will always exist.

"I support cutting welfare to empower individuals to take control of their own lives," Cutting concluded.

No Place For Puritanical Drug Laws, Says Libz Leader

Libertarianz Party leader and Wairarapa electorate candidate Richard McGrath has backed Don Brash's calls for marijuana to be decriminalized, saying his party supports full legalization of the cannabis trade.

"My party supports the immediate legalization of all drugs that are considered safer than alcohol," he said, "and the gradual legalization of all other recreational substances."

"There is no longer a place for the enforcement of puritanical laws that make people's bodies the property of the state," he added.

"Drug use is a health issue, not a legal one. Legalisation of drug possession in Portugal over the last 10 years has resulted in less drug use overall, including in the under 18 age group, lower rates of HIV infection, and more people coming forward for assistance with problems associated with drug use. There is no reason to be frightened of giving people back sovereignty over their bodies."

"Fundamentally, the issue of drug use is a moral one, with the fundamental question being: who owns your body – you, or the politicians?"

"The Libertarianz Party supports Don Brash on this issue, and believe what applies to cannabis should equally apply to other substances as well."

Libertarianz for North Shore

Takapuna identity and long time North Shore resident, Michael Murphy is again contesting the North Shore seat for the Libertarianz Party in the forth coming election.

Michael hopes it will be third time lucky as he has contested the seat for the past two elections.

In appears that some of the other parties are so short of membership on the Shore they have had to resort to out sourcing to find candidates to stand for the electorate. "Smug, contemptible, irrational fear mongering" is how Libertarianz Deputy Leader and Ohariu candidate Sean Fitzpatrick described the October 4th press release by Associate Health Busy-Body, Peter Dunne.

"The United-Peter Party leader shows utter contempt for the rights of people over their own bodies in his decision to ban 3 more synthetic cannabis products."

"Clearly his own drug of choice – power – is one heady brew he is in no hurry to go cold turkey from," Fitzpatrick says.

In his release, Dunne snorts, "I have removed 43 products already; if I have to remove another 43, so be it." You can almost hear him salivating at the prospect of getting his next fix.

Fitzpatrick suggests the time has come for the people of Ohariu to help Dunne shake off his addiction to power by voting him out of office, keeping in mind the Labour, Green and National Parties are no better, if not even worse.

"Libertarianz is the only party that is founded on the principle of self ownership. Your life and your body are your property to do with as you please. The only restriction is you do not infringe on the rights of others."

"In this regard the addiction to power seen in politicians is the vilest scourge on civilized society and needs to be addressed urgently." Fitzpatrick concludes.
